








# HOW TO DRAW A JELLYFISH

<p>4</p>  <p>Add a few more tentacles of varying lengths and shapes.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Draw two small eyes and a smiling mouth to give your jellyfish a cute expression.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Add more thin, flowing lines extending from the body to represent additional tentacles.</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Add curved lines on the jellyfish's body to create a sense of depth and texture.</p>	<p>8</p> <p>Add some color and maybe a few creature friends!</p>
