








HOW TO DRAW A SEAHORSE

Did you know that seahorses can move their eyes independently of each other? This allows them to look in different directions at the same time, helping them spot predators and prey more easily!

<p>1</p>  <p>Draw a curved line like a "3" with a spiral tail.</p>	<p>2</p>  <p>Add a line inside the tail spiral and extend it up to give the seahorse a belly.</p>	<p>3</p>  <p>Sketch the head, adding a bump for the nose.</p>
<p>4</p>  <p>Draw detailed texture lines on the belly.</p>	<p>5</p>  <p>Draw the mouth, and add bumps along the head.</p>	<p>6</p>  <p>Refine body details for a segmented look.</p>
<p>7</p>  <p>Add the dorsal fin on the back and don't forget the eye.</p>	<p>8</p> <p>Add some color and maybe a few creature friends!</p>
